

Upon arrival, transfer from Oaxaca City airport to the hotel. Welcome dinner.

Day 2. Mitla and Hierve el Agua – Sunday

Breakfast at the hotel. Early in the morning the group will meet in the lobby to visit the Tule, the oldest tree with an age of more than 2000 years, it is worth mentioning that it is also the tree with thelargest diameter.

Next they will visit the archaeological zone of Mitla, a word of Nahuatl origin that means "place of the dead", and in Zapotec it is known as Liobaa, "house of tombs". At the fall of Monte Alban, around 750 A.D., Mitla was one of the cities where the political and religious power of the Zapotecs of the Central Valleys was concentrated until the arrival of the Spaniards.

You will then board the bus to Hierve el Agua, a system of petrified waterfalls, formed by calcium carbonate.

The waterfalls are 100% natural and were formed thousands

years ago by the runoff of water with a high mineral content. You can take a 40-minute walk along a trail to see this paradise from another perspective. Free time to enjoy this natural beauty.

Day 3. Monte Albán, Alebrijes y Barro negro Monday

Breakfast at the hotel. Early departure to the Archaeological Zone of Monte Alban, the most important pre-Hispanic city of the classical era, in addition to its interesting site museum with the original stelae found in the area.

Continue to a town that works the famous alebrijes of Oaxaca

(Arrezola), there will be free time in the area. Then you will visit San Bartolo Coyotepec, site where the burnishing and the formation of the typical Oaxacan black clay was discovered, you will have a workshop where the way to work this precious art of pottery will be explained. At the end of the workshop we will return to the hotel. Free time at leisure.

Day 4. Downtown & Huatulco – Tuesday

Breakfast at the hotel. Early today the group will tour the streets of Oaxaca, a beautiful colonial destination, the group will be able to admire the impressive historical monuments linked to a rich indigenous tradition that has been maintained over the years. You will visit the Zocalo, the Cathedral, the Santo Domingo Cultural Center, the Museum of Contemporary Art, the Rufino Tamayo Museum of Pre-Hispanic Art.



Day 5 - 7. Huatulco – Wednesday to Friday

Day 8. Return home

Breakfast at the hotel, at the proper time you will take the transfer.
