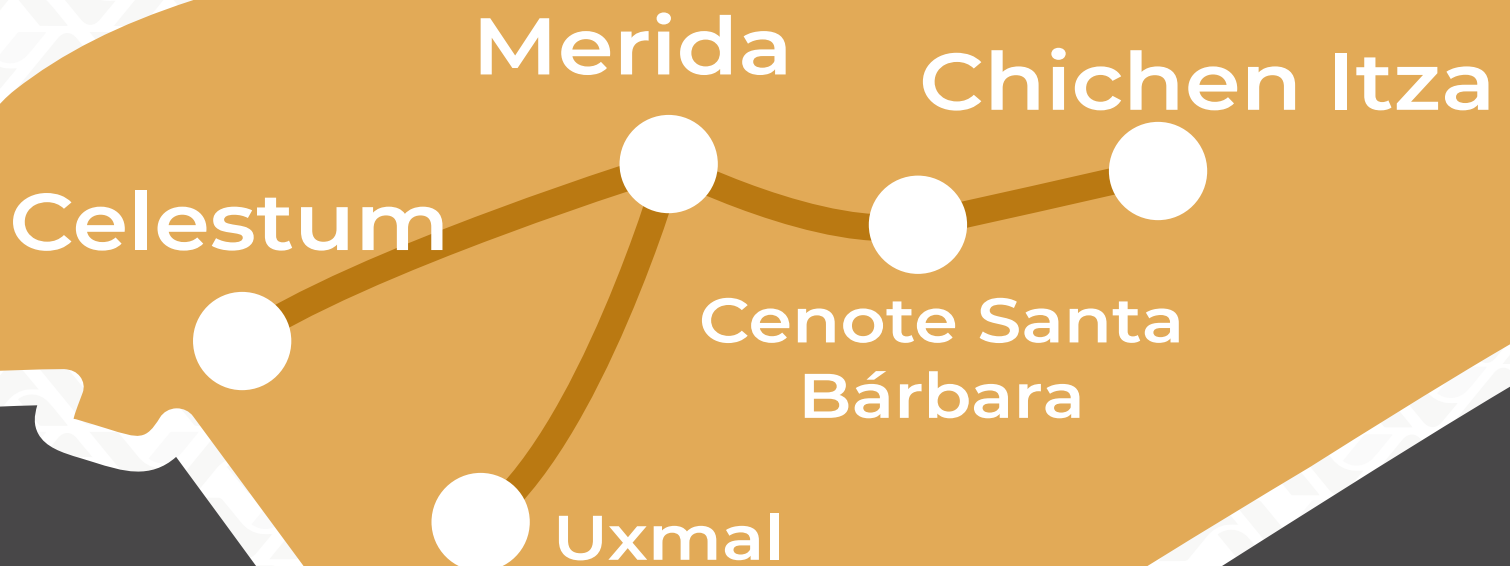

## Day 1. Aeropuerto Mérida - City Tour

Reception at Manuel Crescencio Rejón Airport.

Transfer to the hotel. Meeting at Carnavalito's offices.

Later, we will visit the beautiful "White City," home to some of Yucatan's greatest treasures: the elegant Paseo Montejo, the ancient Cathedral, the Regional Museum of Anthropology, and the best restaurants to enjoy cochinita pibil, queso relleno, and papadzules. We will explore the most emblematic points aboard the "Carnavalito," a typical truck used for city tours. The rest of the afternoon is free. Passengers will return to the hotel on their own.

Overnight in Mérida.

## Day 2. Mérida - Chichen Itzá - Mérida

Breakfast at the hotel.

Transfer to the famous ruins of Chichén Itzá, which means "Mouth of the well of the water sorcerers" in the Mayan language. It was the most important city between the years 900 and 1300 of our era. The most famous building is the Temple of Kukulcán or "El Castillo," which, along with the Temple of the Warriors, the ball court, the astronomical observatory, and the complex of the nuns, showcases the ceremonial character of the city.

During the spring equinox (March 21) and the autumn equinox (September 21), an effect of light and shadows projects a descending serpent on the northern staircase of the Castillo, symbolizing the mandate to attend to agricultural tasks before the rainy season. Return to Mérida. Overnight in Mérida.

## Day 3. Mérida - Celestún - Mérida

Breakfast at the hotel.

Afterwards, we will travel 109 km to Celestún, a Biosphere Reserve located in a coastal corridor of wetlands with the best conservation in the western part of the peninsula: mangroves, dunes, "petenes" (unique ecosystems), low jungle, and grasslands that protect natural evolutionary processes.

Here, the most exotic species of Yucatan's geography coexist. Over 300 bird species have been recorded, with the beautiful pink flamingo standing out. We will take a boat ride along the mangrove trails to discover this special ecosystem with its unique balance.

Later, we will return to Mérida.

## Day 4. Mérida - Cenotes de Santa Bárbara - Mérida

Breakfast at the hotel.

Meeting in the hotel lobby to head to Santa Bárbara, where we will appreciate the uniqueness of 3 cenotes - one located in a cave, the next semi-open, and the last one completely open, all surrounded by wonderful native flora and fauna. Here, we can swim in the midst of a natural environment. Later, we will head back to the city of Mérida.

Overnight in Mérida.

## Day 5. Mérida - Uxmal - Mérida

Breakfast at the hotel.

Afterwards, we will head to Uxmal, known as "the three times built." It is located in a hilly area called Puuc, which breaks the monotony of the Yucatan plain. Uxmal was the most important city in the region and had a population of 20,000 at its peak (600 - 900 AD). It comprises 15 groups of buildings covering about 2km, with highlights including the Pyramid of the Magician (35 meters high), the Nunnery Quadrangle, and the Governor's Palace.

What makes Uxmal unique compared to other Mayan sites are its architectural style and the arrangement of its buildings, strategically positioned for astronomical observations, such as tracking the movement of the planet Venus. Additionally, the ancient Maya ingeniously constructed chultunes, cisterns used to store water since there are no cenotes in this area.

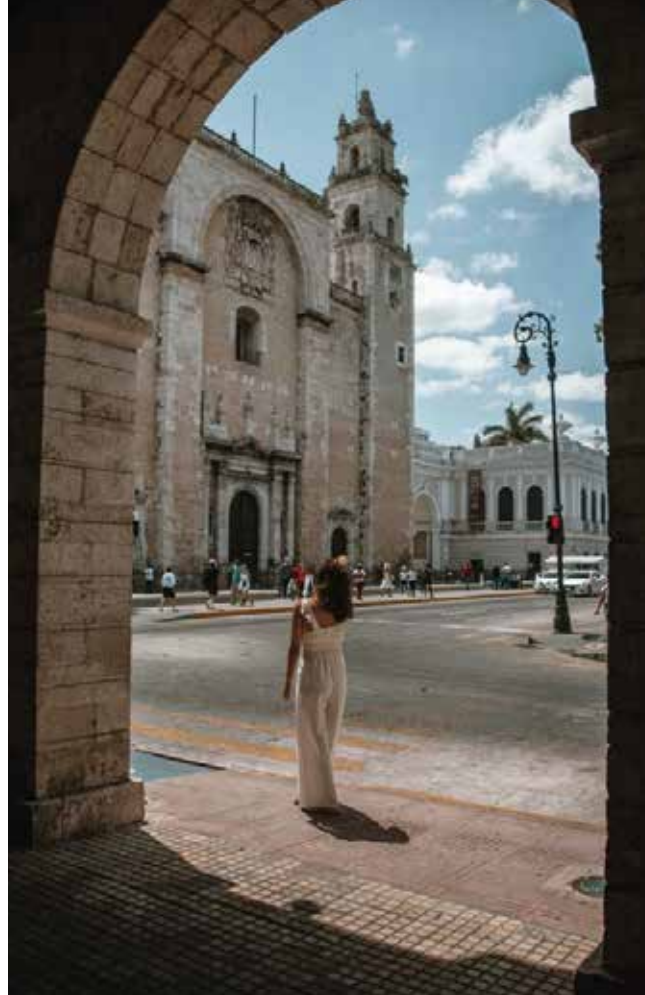
